CAPITAL HIGH SCHOOL'S EAGLE PRIDE PLAYERS CONSTITUTION AND CONTRACT

The Advanced Acting (The Eagle Pride Players) class in which each member is a teacher and a pupil, leader and follower, worker and supervisor. Each person of the Eagle Pride Players must work together to produce a quality production. We, the members of The Eagle Pride Players, chosen by audition, agree upon these standards of behaviors and consequences.

- We uphold the idea that every actor deserves an open environment to learn and perform in.
- We understand that after-school rehearsals are mandatory bar three absences, and Mrs. Fuller and/or Danielle Louie can exercise the right to schedule Saturday rehearsals, deduct points from rehearsal grade and/or remove the actor from the production and/or class at semester.
- We recognize that grade-checks are required, and a 2.00 grade point average, with no grade below a C, must be maintained to participate in productions.
- We agree to respect each other, Mrs. Fuller, Danielle Louie, the Student Directors, our competition, props, set, make-up, costumes, the theater, all of our surroundings and most importantly, ourselves.
- We agree that no actor shall miss more than **THREE** after school rehearsals. More than three absences will result in points deducted from grade. On the **FIFTH** absence, the actor will be removed from the production. Please work to give Mrs. Fuller, Danielle Louie or one of the council members a week's notice if you will be missing rehearsal. We understand family emergencies and illnesses are a different story.
- We agree that lines will be memorized by the assigned due date or points will be deducted from student's grade. Death run-throughs at lunch are NOT a suggestion, but mandatory for all actors involved.
- We agree that a 100-hour minimum plus districts for the year is required for a letter in Theater Arts. Hours must be signed off at the end of each week by either Mrs. Fuller, Danielle Louie, the Council, or Student Directors.
- When traveling we will abide by school rules, and behave in a professional and respectable manner. This includes dress, language, and overall representation of Capital High School.
- If an actor is discovered to be disrespectful, the consequences may include, but is not limited to, suspension, manual labor, fines, or exclusion from activities. Mrs. Fuller, Danielle Louie and/or the Council shall decide on the proper course of action for each individual case.
- The Council, elected by a popular vote of The Eagle Pride Players, shall meet once a week to problem-solve and plan forthcoming events.
- This Constitution will be ratified by the Council and may be amended by Mrs. Fuller or the Council as they see fit.
